Mr. Uldric L. Fiore, Jr. ("Ric") assumed duties as Director, Soldier & Family Legal Services on 16 July 2008. Mr. Fiore is responsible for policy and oversight of legal services provided to soldiers and their families, including legal assistance and claims services, with particular emphasis on legal support to Army Wounded Warriors in the Medical Evaluation and Physical Disability Evaluation processes.

From May 2005 to July 2008, Mr. Fiore served as General Counsel for the Department of Defense Office of Inspector General, with responsibility for ensuring independent counsel and legal advice to the Inspector General and to the Office of Inspector General senior managers across the range of Inspector General mission and functions, including criminal and administrative investigations, audits, inspections and reviews.

Mr. Fiore began his federal service following graduation in 1973 from the United States Military Academy and commissioning in the United States Army, where he went on to serve for 30 years, 25 of which were in The Judge Advocate General's Corps, from which he retired with the rank of Colonel. From July 2000 to his Army retirement in July 2003, Mr. Fiore served as Chief of the Army Litigation Division, which has the mission to represent the Department of the Army and Army officials in civil litigation before Federal, State, and international courts. Following his retirement until May 2005, Mr. Fiore served as an Assistant United States Attorney in the Civil Division of the United States Attorney's Office for the District of Columbia.

Mr. Fiore's prior military assignments include: Judge Advocate, United Nations Command, U.S. Forces Korea and Eighth U.S. Army, Republic of Korea (ROK); Staff Judge Advocate, U.S. Army Special Operations Command, Fort Bragg, NC; Staff Judge Advocate, U.S. Army Engineer Center, Fort Leonard Wood, MO; Staff Judge Advocate, U.S. Army Transportation Center, Fort Eustis, VA; Litigation Attorney, Procurement Fraud Division, Office of The Judge Advocate General (HQDA); Deputy Staff Judge Advocate, 10<sup>th</sup> Mountain Division, Fort Drum, NY; Trial Attorney, Contract Appeals Division, Office of The Judge Advocate General (HQDA); Deputy Staff Judge Advocate, 2d Infantry Division, ROK; Senior Trial Counsel, Eighth U.S. Army, ROK; and prior to law school, Platoon Leader, 125<sup>th</sup> Signal Battalion, 25<sup>th</sup> Infantry Division, Hawaii.

Mr. Fiore's military decorations include the Defense Superior Service Medal, Legion of Merit (2<sup>nd</sup> Award), Meritorious Service Medal with Silver Oak Leaf (6<sup>th</sup> Award), Army Commendation Medal, National Defense Service Medal, Korea Service Medal, Army Service Ribbon, Overseas Service Ribbon, and the Republic of Korea Order of National Security Merit Samil Medal. Mr. Fiore also has earned the Parachutist Badge, Ranger Tab, and Australian Parachutist Wings.

Mr. Fiore is admitted to practice before the Bars of the States of New Jersey and New York, and the District of Columbia, as well as various Federal Courts. Mr. Fiore earned his Juris Doctor with honors from Rutgers University, School of Law (Newark), and a Bachelor of Science from the United States Military Academy. He also is a graduate of the Army War College and the Army Command and General Staff College.
