

MEMORANDUM FOR RECORD

SUBJECT: FY14 JAGC Reserve Non-AGR COL Promotion Selection Board Results Review

1. Board Synopsis:

a. Summary of Board Actions.

(1) The board selected 5 officers from the primary zone (PZ) and 7 officers from above the zone (AZ), for a total of 12 selections. This equates to a DOPMA selection rate of 46% (total selected divided by considered PZ population).

(2) The PZ selection rate was 19% with 5 of 26 officers selected.

(3) The AZ selection rate was 5% with 7 of 129 officers selected.

(4) There were no selections from below the zone.

b. All but one of the selectees had a Most Qualified (MQ)/ACOM rating on each of their last two OERs. Of the PZ selectees, 80% had MQ/ACOM ratings on each of their last three OERs.

c. One hundred percent of PZ selectees served in a leadership position as an SJA, DSJA, CJA, RDC, and/or Deputy Commander.

d. Women accounted for 20% of the PZ population and 8% of the selectees. Minority officers accounted for 40% of the PZ population and 33% of the selectees.

e. Eighty-three percent of selectees had deployed or mobilized in support of Overseas Contingency Operations.

f. Seventy-five percent of selectees had completed Senior Service College.
