Ms. Diane M. Nugent is the senior civilian attorney in The Judge Advocate General's Corps (JAGC) and Chief, Labor and Employment Law Division, Office of The Judge Advocate General. She provides legal advice to the Army Staff and Secretariat on civilian personnel policy and other matters involving and affecting Army civilian employees including labor relations and civil rights. She oversees the Army Labor Counselor Program and leads a division of talented advisors and litigators. She is also a special advisor to The Judge Advocate General on matters related to JAGC civilian employees with special emphasis on the professional development of the over 480 civilian attorneys in the Judge Advocate Legal Service. Ms. Nugent oversees the JAG Corps' Civilian Attorney Professional Development Program and provides advice on civilian attorney issues to other senior JAG Corps leaders.

Ms. Nugent is a 2000 graduate of the Industrial College of the Armed Forces, where she received a M.S. in National Resource Strategy. In 1983, she earned her J.D, with honors, from the Marshall Wythe School of Law, College of William and Mary, Williamsburg, Virginia. Ms. Nugent is a 1979 graduate of Saint Mary's College, Notre Dame, Indiana, where she received her B.A.

A former Army Judge Advocate, Ms. Nugent has a distinguished career in government service that spans over two decades with the Department of the Army.
