**TO THE HONORABLE, THE JUDGES OF THE UNITED STATES ARMY  
COURT OF CRIMINAL APPEALS**

COME NOW the undersigned appellate defense counsel, pursuant to Rules 23 and 24 of this court's Rules of Appellate Procedure, and move this court to grant appellant's Motion for Extension of Time. The undersigned appellate defense counsel request a 30-day extension of time until 16 October 2021 to file a Brief on Behalf of Appellant.

1. Consistent with Army Reg. 27-26, Rules of Professional Conduct for Lawyers, undersigned counsel request additional time to ensure that all due diligence has been done to adequately review, investigate, research, and brief the assignments of error in this case and to fulfil counsel's ethical obligation to represent Appellant's interest.

2. The record of trial in this contested case is 1624 pages. The approved sentence was adjudged on 17 May 2017, and it includes a bad-conduct discharge and reduction to Private E-3. His sentence rehearing sentenced him to reduction to E-5. Appellant concurs with the request for an extension.

3. The current due date is 16 September 2021. Defense counsel requests additional time to review the record, research issues, and confer with appellant.

4. The first undersigned defense counsel has 17 cases pending at this court and 11 pending at the Court of Appeals for the Armed Forces. Undersigned counsel was assigned this case on 31 May 2021.

5. Counsel anticipate briefing multiple substantive assignment of errors to this Court.

WHEREFORE, appellate defense counsel respectfully request that this Court grant the instant motion.




