COMES NOW the undersigned appellate defense counsel, pursuant to
Rules 23 and 24 of this court's Rules of Appellate Procedure, and moves for
a 30-day extension of time until 9 July 2022 to file a Brief on Behalf of
Appellant.


1. Consistent with Army Reg. 27-26, Rules of Professional Conduct for
Lawyers, undersigned counsel request additional time to ensure that
all due diligence has been done to adequately review, investigate,
research, and brief the assignments of error in this case and to fulfill
counsel's ethical obligation to represent Appellant's interest.

2. The entire record is 642 pages. A military judge sitting as a general court martial found appellant guilty in accordance with his pleas of one specification of premeditated murder and one specification of violating a lawful order. (Charge Sheet). The military judge sentenced appellant to be confined for 62 years, reduction to the grade of E-1 and a dishonorable discharge. Appellant consents to the extension.
3. The current due date is 9 June 2022. Appellate defense counsel has requested additional records and requests an extension of time in order to complete her review of the case file, conduct appropriate research, and complete the brief on behalf of appellant.
4. Undersigned counsel currently has fifteen other cases pending a Brief on Behalf of Appellant before this Court, including six contested Courts Martial.

WHEREFORE, appellate defense counsel respectfully requests that this court grant the instant motion.




