TO THE HONORABLE, THE JUDGES OF THE UNITED STATES ARMY  
COURT OF CRIMINAL APPEALS

COME NOW the undersigned appellate defense counsel, pursuant to Rules  
23 and 24.1 of this court’s Rules of Appellate Procedure, and move for a 30-day  
extension of time to file appellant’s brief, to 21 September 2022.

As good cause for granting this extension, the undersigned counsel hereby  
assert:

1. Appellant’s trial was a guilty plea to murder, among other charges and specifications.
2. The transcript contains 299 pages, the stipulation of fact is 109 pages, and the other prosecution exhibits are over 500 pages of primarily text.

3. On 22 September 2021, appellant was sentenced to be confined for life with eligibility for parole. His agreement with the convening authority capped his confinement to 70 years.

4. Appellant is currently confined.

5. Appellant consents to extension requests.

6. This extension will allow additional time to confer with appellant and to ensure all issues are appropriately and fully briefed with this court.

7. The undersigned counsel believe that the requested extension is in the best interest of appellant and that denying this request will materially prejudice appellant's rights.

WHEREFORE, appellate defense counsel respectfully request that this court grant the instant motion.






