TO THE HONORABLE, THE JUDGES OF THE UNITED STATES ARMY
COURT OF CRIMINAL APPEALS

COME NOW the undersigned appellate defense counsel, pursuant to Rules 23 and 24 of this Court's Rules of Appellate Procedure, and move to file a 30-day extension until 10 May 2023 to file appellant's brief.

Consistent with Army Reg. 27-26, Rules of Professional Conduct for Lawyers, undersigned counsel request additional time to ensure that all due diligence has been done to adequately review, investigate, research, and brief the assignments of error in this case and to fulfil counsel's ethical obligation to represent appellant's interest.

The transcript in this contested case contains 820 pages. The approved sentence was adjudged on 4 May 2022, and it includes confinement for nine years

and 10 days and dismissal from the service. Appellant is still in confinement.

Appellant concurs with this request.

The brief is currently due 10 April 2023. Appellant requests a 30-day extension of time to 10 May 2023. Civilian defense counsel currently has pending 49 cases: 19 cases before this court, seven cases before the Court of Appeals for the Armed Forces, three cases before the Air Force Court of Criminal Appeals, one before the Navy-Marine Court of Criminal Appeals, nine clemency cases, six cases before the Federal Court of Claims, and four petitions for Writs of Habeas Corpus.

The undersigned counsel request additional time to finalize and submit appellant's brief.

WHEREFORE, appellate defense counsel respectfully request that this court grant the instant motion.


