ORDER

WHEREAS:

On 14 April 2023, appellant filed a motion for appellate discovery relating to the circumstances surrounding the replacement of the military judge in his case. On 09 May 2023, the motion was granted in part and denied in part.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:


1. Appellate government counsel shall obtain an affidavit from Colonel (COL) Jack Pritchard describing the reason(s) for his replacement as the military judge in the above captioned case. The affidavit shall also address the detailing of Lieutenant Colonel (LTC) Tom Hynes to the case at hand.
2. Colonel Jack Pritchard shall attach any documents, including email messages, relevant to his replacement not otherwise found in the record of trial. The government may provide COL Jack Pritchard any portion of the record that may assist him in his response, but may not provide him any sealed portion of the record absent further order of this Court.
3. Appellate government counsel shall obtain an affidavit from LTC Tom Hynes, describing, to the best of his knowledge and belief at the time, the reason(s) for his detailing as the military judge in the above captioned case.
4. Lieutenant Colonel Tom Hynes shall attach any documents, including email messages, relevant to his detailing not otherwise found in the record of trial. The government may provide LTC Tom Hynes any portion of the record that may assist him in his response, but may not provide him any sealed portion of the record absent further order of this Court.

5. Appellate government counsel shall obtain the affidavits from COL Jack Pritchard and LTC Tom Hynes, along with any other documents provided, and file them with this Court no later than 30 days from the date of this order.
