ORDER

WHEREAS:

On 20 April 2023, appellant filed a motion for appellate discovery relating to the circumstances surrounding the replacement of the military judge in his case. On 4 May 2023, the motion was granted in part and denied in part.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. Appellate government counsel shall obtain an affidavit from Colonel (COL) Jack Pritchard describing the reason(s) for his replacement as the military judge in the above-captioned case. The affidavit should also include all information and knowledge, if any, COL Jack Pritchard possesses regarding the detailing of an Air Force military judge to appellant's case instead of another Army military judge.
2. COL Jack Pritchard shall attach any and all documents, including email messages, relevant to support his affidavit not otherwise found in the record of trial. The government may provide COL Jack Pritchard any portion of the record that may assist him in his response, but may not provide him any sealed portion of the record absent further order of this Court.
3. Appellate government counsel shall obtain the affidavit from COL Jack Pritchard, along with any other documents provided, and file them with this no later than thirty days from the date of this order.
