ORDER

WHEREAS:

On 20 January 2023, appellant filed his brief to this Court alleging prosecutorial misconduct. 
NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

2. Appellate government counsel may provide Major Stacey Cain any portion of the record that may assist in securing the relevant note(s), but may not provide any sealed portion of the record absent further order of this court.
3. Upon completion, appellate government counsel shall obtain from Major Stacey Cain such note(s) and file them with this court no later than seven days from the date of this order.
