
TO THE HONORABLE, THE JUDGES OF THE

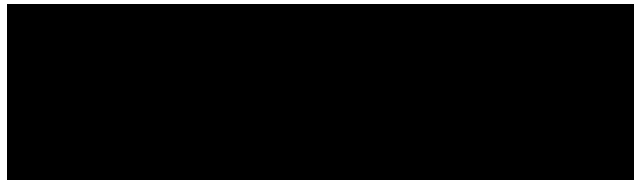
