COME NOW the undersigned appellate defense counsel, pursuant to Rules 23 and 24 of this Court's Rules of Appellate Procedure, and move to file a 30-day extension until 13 July 2023 to file appellant's brief.

Consistent with Army Reg. 27-26, Rules of Professional Conduct for Lawyers, undersigned counsel request additional time to ensure that all due diligence has been done to adequately review, investigate, research, and brief the assignments of error in this case and to fulfil counsel's ethical obligation to represent appellant's interest.

The transcript in this contested case contains 966 pages. The approved sentence was adjudged on 1 April 2022, and it includes confinement for eighteen

months and dismissal from the service. Appellant is not in confinement.

Appellant concurs with this request.

The brief is currently due 13 June 2023. Appellant requests a 30-day extension of time to 13 July 2023.

Civilian defense counsel currently has pending 6 cases: 3 cases before this court (*Nieves, Dine, Rudometkin*), 4 cases before the Air Force Court of Criminal Appeals (*Ramirez, Byrne, Henderson, Hennessy*), and one SCOTUS petition for a writ of certiorari to the CAAF (*Lattin*).


Civilian counsel was traveling overseas and to the Naval Consolidated Brig Charleston from 9 May to 26 May 2023 and unable to work on cases.

WHEREFORE, appellate defense counsel respectfully request that this court grant the instant motion.


