TO THE HONORABLE, THE JUDGES OF THE  
UNITED STATES ARMY COURT OF CRIMINAL APPEALS

COMES NOW the undersigned appellate defense counsel, pursuant to Rules 23 and 24 of this court's Rules of Appellate Procedure, and moves this court to grant appellant's Motion for Extension. The undersigned appellate defense counsel requests a 30-day extension of time until 14 December 2024 to file a Brief on Behalf of Appellant. The Brief on Behalf of Appellant is currently due on 14 November 2024. Pursuant to Rule 24.1(b), the undersigned counsel asserts:

1. On 25 January 2024, a military judge sitting as a general court-martial convicted appellant, in accordance with his pleas, of three specifications of indecent recording in violation of Article 120c, UCMJ. (Charge Sheet; R. at 62). The same day, the military judge sentenced appellant to confinement for forty-five days and a bad-conduct discharge. (R. at 88).

2. On 5 February 2024, the convening authority took no action on the findings and sentence. (Action). On 15 February 2024, the military judge entered judgment. (Judgment). This court docketed appellant's case on 17 June 2024. (Referral).

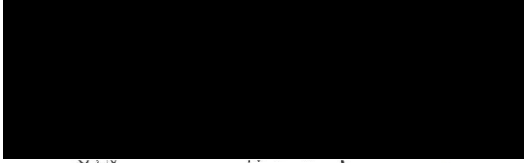
3. Appellant's electronic record of trial is 259 pages, including 89 transcript pages.

4. Appellant is not in confinement.

5. Good cause exists for this extension. Undersigned counsel made initial contact with appellant. However, since initial contact, undersigned counsel has been unable to contact appellant despite reasonable efforts using multiple methods of communication. Undersigned counsel continues to attempt to contact appellant.

6. Consistent with Army Reg. 27-26, Rules of Professional Conduct for Lawyers, undersigned counsel requests additional time to contact appellant to adequately consult with him regarding his appeal and to fulfill counsel's ethical obligation to represent his interests.


WHEREFORE, appellate defense counsel respectfully requests this court grant the instant motion for an extension until 14 December 2024.
