WHEREAS:


The record of trial states the court-martial was convened by Court-Martial Convening Order Number 1, pursuant to Secretary of the Army, General Order Number 37, dated 18 August 1988, designating the Garrison Commander of Fort Belvoir as a General Court-martial Convening Authority. This General Order is not contained in the Record of Trial. The court believes there may be a scrivener's error in Court-Martial Convening Order Number 1, which should reference Secretary of the Army, General Order Number 36, dated 15 August 1988.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

Appellate government counsel shall obtain Secretary of the Army, General Order Number 37, dated 18 August 1988, and Secretary of the Army, General Order Number 36, dated 15 August 1988. Appellate government counsel shall then file a motion to supplement the record with this Court no later than seven days from the date of this order.
