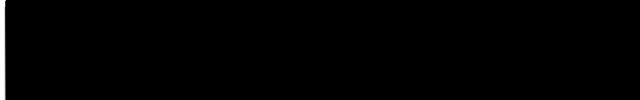
NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:
