1. The trial court's 28 May 2025 ruling in the above captioned case, ordering the disclosure of Petitioner's records, is stayed pending further direction from this Court.

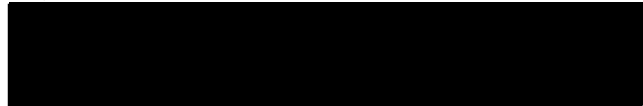
2. Petitioner shall have until 9 June 2025 to file supplemental briefing.
