**TO THE HONORABLE, THE JUDGES OF THE UNITED STATES ARMY
COURT OF CRIMINAL APPEALS**

COME NOW the undersigned appellate defense counsel, pursuant to Rules
23 and 24 of this Court's Internal Rules of Practice and Procedure, and move for a
30-day extension of time until 25 April 2021 to file a Brief on Behalf of Appellant.

1. Consistent with Army Reg. 27-26, Rules of Professional Conduct for Lawyers, undersigned counsel request additional time to ensure that all due diligence has been done to adequately review, investigate, research, and brief the assignments of error in this case and to fulfil counsel's ethical obligation to represent Appellant's interest.
2. The record of trial in this contested case is 645 pages. The approved sentence was adjudged on 1 July 2020, and it includes a reprimand, a dishonorable discharge, and reduction to Private E-1. Appellant concurs with the request for an extension.

3. The current due date is 26 March 2021. Defense counsel requests additional time to review the record, research issues, and confer with appellant.
4. The first undersigned defense counsel has four federal cases (one contested) this month.
5. Counsel anticipate briefing multiple substantive assignment of errors to this Court.

WHEREFORE, appellate defense counsel respectfully request that this Court grant the instant motion.


