## WHEREAS:


Appellant's case is pending review before this Court pursuant to Article 66, Uniform Code of Military Justice, 10 U.S.C. § 866. On 22 June 2021, appellee filed a motion to examine and photocopy appellant's brief, previously filed under seal with this Court's approval on 26 April 2021. Appellee's motion is based on the need for appellate government counsel to review appellant's brief in its entirety and obtain a copy for reference while drafting a response to issues raised by appellant.

## NOW THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

Appellant's motion to examine and photocopy appellant's brief is GRANTED. Appellant's brief shall remain under seal. Appellate government counsel may make one photocopy of appellant's brief. No other copies of the sealed matters—physical, digital, or otherwise—may be made. Appellate government counsel shall not disclose the sealed matters or information any further without prior approval from this Court. Appellate government counsel may continue to use the sealed information within appropriate pleadings in representing the government subject to the Court's Rules of Appellate Procedure. Upon completion of the appellate process, counsel must destroy the document immediately.
