WHEREAS:

On 12 July 2021, petitioner filed a petition with this Court seeking extraordinary relief in the form of a writ of mandamus to the military judge presiding over a court-martial in which petitioner asserts a claim under Article 6b, Uniform Code of Military Justice, 10 U.S.C. § 806b.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

The United States Army Government Appellate Division will obtain and file with this court:

a. Authenticated transcripts, together with relevant exhibits, from court-martial sessions relating to Petitioner's Brief in Support of Petition for Extraordinary Relief in the Form of a Writ of Mandamus ("Petitioner's Brief"). Such transcripts will include the evidence presented, argument by counsel, and any findings of fact, conclusions of law, and rulings by the military judge on the matter.

b. A copy of all records turned over by petitioner's special victim counsel to the government on 7 May 2021, referenced in Appendix F of Petitioner's Brief.

c. The sealed appellate exhibits containing the unredacted version of Petitioner's original Post Traumatic Stress Disorder Questionnaire, referenced in Appendix D of Petitioner's Brief.
