FORUM CHOICE.

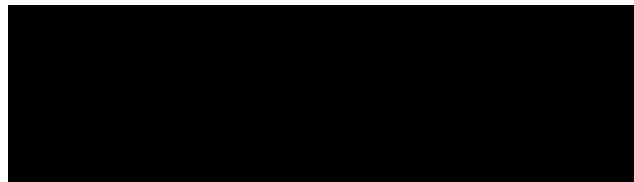
IV.
