Notice is hereby given that a hearing in this case before the United States Army Court of Criminal Appeals, has been set for Wednesday, 29 October 2025, at 1000 hours. Argument will be heard on the following issue:

I.

WHETHER THE MILITARY JUDGE ERRED WHEN HE FOUND THAT APPELLANT BREACHED A PREVIOUS PLEA AGREEMENT WHEN APPELLANT PLED AND WAS FOUND GUILTY AND THE ONLY CONDITION IN THE AGREEMENT WAS FOR HIM TO PLEAD GUILTY.

II.

WHETHER APPELLANT'S CONVICTION IN A GENERAL COURT-MARTIAL FOR THE SAME OFFENSE HE HAD ALREADY BEEN CONVICTED OF IN A SUMMARY COURT-MARTIAL VIOLATED HIS CONSTITUTIONAL AND STATUTORY DUE PROCESS RIGHTS AND PROTECTIONS AGAINST DOUBLE JEOPARDY.
