
DECISION ON FURTHER REVIEW

Per Curiam:

On 25 November 2019, this court set aside the findings of guilty and the sentence. *See United States v. Pruett*, ARMY 20180368, 2019 CCA LEXIS 468 (Army Ct. Crim. App. 25 Nov. 2019) (summ. disp.). The record of trial was returned to The Judge Advocate General for submission to the same or a different convening authority for a rehearing. That action has been completed and the record is now before us for further review.

On consideration of the entire record, including consideration of the issues personally specified by the appellant, we hold the findings of guilty and the sentence, as approved by the convening authority, correct in law and fact. Accordingly, those findings of guilty and the sentence are AFFIRMED.
