

Research Tip: Searching Website Domains

Trying to find an Army Regulation that addresses an issue you've never seen before? You know there's a DoDI on topic, but do not remember what the number is? Use Google to search the website's domain! Here's how:

1. Navigate to <https://www.google.com>;
2. In the Google search bar, type "site:" followed by the website you want to search and the search term. See below:

To search the DoD Directorate site:



3. Your results:



4. Note: There is no space between "site:" and the website; make sure you delete "www." and "https://" before the website; and there **IS** a space between the website and your search term.
