Rebecca E. Ausprung is a senior civilian attorney in The Judge Advocate General's Corps and the Director of Civil Law and Litigation. She serves as senior advisor to The Judge Advocate General, the Commander of the U.S. Army Legal Services Agency, and senior Army leadership on civil law and litigation. She is responsible for making policy recommendations to four active litigating divisions with over 100 attorneys and paralegal support staff. The portfolios she oversees include: military and civilian personnel law litigation, commercial litigation, regulatory and intellectual property law, FOIA/Privacy Act, tort litigation, contract litigation and appeals, and environmental law and litigation.

Ms. Ausprung has had a distinguished career of government service that spans nearly two decades with the Department of the Army. Her military service includes serving as a Litigation Attorney, Military Personnel Branch, U.S. Army Litigation Division; Senior Defense Counsel, Wuerzburg Field Office; Trial Defense Counsel, Kitzingen Law Center; and Legal Assistance Attorney and later Trial Counsel, III Corps and Fort Hood. As a civilian, she served as the Chief of Civilian Personnel Litigation, U.S. Army Litigation Division. She also performed a detail as the Acting Chief of the Army's Labor and Employment Law Division.

Ms. Ausprung holds a Bachelor of Arts from Kent State University and a Juris Doctor from the Ohio State University College of Law. She is a graduate of the

Federal Executive Institute and the Army Management Staff College and is a member of the State Bar of Texas.
