1. This message expires on 1 August 2025.
2. This message announces the release of the Fiscal Year (FY) 2024 Active Component (AC) Army Judge Advocate General's Corps (JAGC) Senior Service College (SSC) Selection Board Results. Officers selected will be slated to attend SSC during Academic Year (AY) 2025-2026.
3. The official release date is 2 October 2024.
4. HRC will publish a list of principals and revalidated officers in alphabetical order. Alternate activations for Academic Year (AY) 2025-2026 will be notified by the branch. The approved list will be posted on the HRC website under the "Active Officer Selection Boards."
5. Principals in the following duty categories, which must be verified by the officers' career branch, will be considered Policy Deferments. Officers who are considered a policy deferment, are not required to submit a deferment request.
  - a. Officers in key billets with a projected change of assignment date after 30 September 2025.
  - b. Officers with less than 12 months' time on station (24 months OCONUS) based on an SSC school report date on or about 1 August 2025.
  - c. Officers in deployed units.
6. Officers slated to attend SSC are expected to attend SSC in their selected academic year (AY). Commands will ensure officers have ample time to meet SSC report dates and should work with the officer's career branch.
7. Principals who wish to request a deferment that is not in the above duty categories, will be considered "discretionary" in nature. All discretionary deferments should originate with a written request from the officer and be endorsed by the officer's Commanding General. Requests will

be forwarded to Career Managers NLT 2359 on 4 November 2024. Approved deferred principals will be subject to revalidation by the next SSC selection board. Deferrals will not be granted to officers activated from the alternate list.

8. Commanders should support SSC attendance for their personnel and discourage deferment requests. Requests for deferments will be closely scrutinized. Approval authority for all Judge Advocate request for deferments will be forwarded to OTJAG Personal, Plans, and Training Office for decision by TJAG.

9. Officers who wish to decline attendance will notify their career branch in writing as soon as possible for appropriate guidance. Principal officers declining attendance will no longer be eligible for SSC selection, revalidation, or attendance.

10. Invitations for the Army War College Distance Education Program (AWCDEP), Class of 2025-2027, will be extended to eligible officers via their career manager in March of 2025. HRC will issue a subsequent MILPER message that covers AWCDEP enrollment instructions for all eligible officers.

11. Questions regarding selection, slating to a specific school, availability, declination, or deferment should be directed to the appropriate career branch manager.
