William J. Koon Director, Professional Programs Office of The Judge Advocate General Headquarters, Department of the Army Washington, D.C.

As Director, Professional Programs, Mr. Koon is responsible for the Judge Advocate General's Corps' Professional and Organizational Development Team, including Recruiting, Retention, Wellness and Leadership. He also supervises the Office of Soldiers' Counsel, Labor and Employment Law Division, and Administrative Services Division. Mr. Koon is responsible for the Army's Labor Counselor Program and continues to serve as the primary legal advisor to HQDA civilian personnel management proponents. He is the Army's Legal Career Field Functional Chief, and the Judge Advocate General's Corps' Senior Civilian.

> Prior to his current position, Mr. Koon served as Director, Civilian Personnel, Labor and Employment Law and as the Functional Chief's Representative for the Legal Career Program (CP-56). Previous assignments include service as the Chief, Civilian Personnel Management for OTJAG and CP-56 Manager, as the Labor Counselor for the Joint Forces Headquarters, National Capital Region and Military District of Washington, and as the Base Realignment and Closure Officer at Fort Ord, CA.

> In 2016, Mr. Koon retired from the United States Army after more than 33 years of service as a Soldier in all three components. He enlisted in the Army in 1983, was commissioned in 1987 through the ROTC program, and served as an Adjutant General Officer in the New York Army National Guard while completing his undergraduate studies and law school. After law school, Mr. Koon joined the JAG Corps and served on active duty at multiple locations before transferring to the Army Reserve and becoming a Department of Army Civilian. While in the reserves, he mobilized twice in support of Operation Enduring Freedom, and deployed to Afghanistan as the Staff Judge Advocate for Task Force Titan, at Camp Sabalu-Harrison. Colonel Koon's final assignment as a Judge Advocate and Soldier was as the Staff Judge Advocate for the 81st Regional Support Command, Fort Jackson, SC.
