1. Southeast Regional Thomas Tang Moot Court Competition	30 SEP - 1 OCT	American Univ CoL- D.C.	National Asian Pacific American Bar Association sponsors this competition; JAs volunteer as judges and visit with students after the competition.
2. NAPABA Regional-Arlington, VA	30 SEP - 1 OCT	Arlington, va	National Asian Pacific American Bar Association regional conference. JAs attend in recruiting capacity to network and talk to attendees about opportunities to serve on Active Duty and in the Reserves. No career fair or presenting role. Annual convention is in November.
3. Georgetown/GW National Security Law Fair	20 OCT 16	Washington, DC	The Georgetown/GW National Security Career Fair is for students from all local law schools. This events gives law students the opportunity to ask questions and gather information from government agencies, non-profits, and the private sector; focusing on a range of pertinent and timely national security law issues.
4. Equal Justice Works	28-29 OCT 16	Arlington, VA	The Equal Justice Works Conference and Career Fair is the largest national public interest legal career fair in the country. More than 160 public interest employers conduct interviews for internships and full-time jobs and meet with students in informal "table talk" discussions of public interest legal
