

Announcement of Death

Mr. Wayne Gullatt, Office of The Judge Advocate General, Pentagon, Washington, DC.

Mr. Wayne Gullatt, who served as the Legal Technology Management Officer for the Office of The Judge Advocate General (OTJAG) and the U.S. Army Legal Services Agency (USALSA), died on 25 January 2012. He was 65 years old.

Wayne was born and raised in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania. In 1965, he graduated from Benjamin Franklin High School in Philadelphia and then served in the Army from 1965 to 1967. He was a Vietnam veteran who earned the Combat Infantryman's Badge (CIB) and the Armed Forces Expeditionary Medal. He began his civilian career with the federal government in 1987 at the Philadelphia Naval Shipyard, where he worked first as a Computer Programmer Analyst and later as an Automated Tool Control Coordinator. Wayne worked at the Philadelphia Naval Shipyard until 1994. In October 1994, he joined USALSA where he provided outstanding IT support to personnel both at USALSA and in OTJAG for over 17 years.

Wayne will be deeply missed by many. He is survived by his wife, Mary; two sons, Dwayne Gullatt and Randy Ingram; a daughter, Tanya Gullatt; and seven grandchildren: Kamryn, Lyles, Amiahand, and Ryan Gullatt; and Joshua, Jonathan, and Summer Scott.

A memorial service was held on Saturday, 4 February 2012 at 1500 at Baker Funeral Home, 2008 N. Broad Street, Philadelphia, Pennsylvania 19121.
