

## **Summer Intern Eligibility Criteria**

1. Age. No age requirements.
2. Citizenship and Personnel Security Requirements. United States citizenship is not required, but applicants must otherwise be eligible for federal civilian employment and able to pass a background investigation.
3. Character. Be of high moral character.
4. Leadership Ability and Interpersonal skills. Have the ability to deal effectively with people and be adaptable leaders.
5. Physical Fitness. No physical fitness requirements for summer interns.
6. Law School. Be a student at a law school accredited by the American Bar Association.
7. Availability. Be available to complete the internship the last summer prior to graduation (example: 3-year students apply during 2L fall to complete the internship the following summer).

## **Summer Intern Application Requirements**

1. Official transcripts of undergraduate, graduate, and law studies.
2. Electronic Application for the U.S. Army Judge Advocate General's Corps Summer Intern Program (available at: <https://www.jagcnet.army.mil/sites/jaro.nsf/homeContent.xsp?open&documentId=8C926049106C25DD85257B2D005136DA> )
3. Records of prior military service, including DD 214, if applicable.
4. A statement or resume of all full-time and part-time work experience (both legal and non-legal).
5. A statement of interest, objectives, and motivation for applying for a summer internship with the JAGC.

6. Field Screening Officer's (FSO) report of interview (find FSOs here: <https://www.jagcnet.army.mil/sites/jaro.nsf/homeContent.xsp?open&documentId=046ADFADDF259A4485257B2D0059BC37> )
7. Letters of recommendation and legal writing sample (optional).
